

## **Colorado National Monument Seeks Community Input on Dynamic Warning Signs on East Hill**

Colorado National Monument is engaging the local community regarding a proposed project at the park. Researchers contracted by the Federal Highway Administration are conducting a pilot project to install two dynamic warning signs to alert motorists to the presence of bicyclists on curvy road sections and the tunnel on the east end of Rim Rock Drive. The purpose of these meetings is to share proposed pilot project plans and get feedback from the public and cycling groups. Rim Rock Drive is a historic property listed on the National Register. New additions to Rim Rock Drive require Section 106 consultation with interested parties in keeping with the National Historic Preservation Act.

The first meeting will be held in Fruita on Wednesday, May 3rd at 5:30 in the Fruita Civic Center Rotary Room (325 E. Aspen).

The second meeting will be held by the Mesa County Bicycling Alliance on Thursday, May 4th at 5:30 pmat the Mesa County Public Library in downtown Grand Junction.
