Information/Discussion Items:

1. 29 Road PEL update – Dean Bressler, GVMPO; Trent Prall, City of Grand Junction; Scott Mai, See PowerPoint presentation.
2. CDOT Project Updates – Jason Smith/Rob Beck/Mark Rogers, CDOT
 - I-70B recommendations to be complete by about the end of the month, then sent to staff and external partners for review. If we get concurrence, design decisions will be finalized.
 - Clifton-design is moving along. ROW impacts aren't as severe as thought except with the school.
 - Shoshana Lew has been named executive director of the Colorado Department of Transportation. She previously served in the Obama administration as chief financial officer and assistant secretary for budget and programs at the U.S. Department of Transportation. Prior to that, she served as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Transportation Policy at USDOT. She also served in the U.S. Department of the Interior and in the Office of Management and Budget. Lew is currently the chief operating officer at the Rhode Island Department of Transportation.
 - SH 141 Colorado River bridge-bids were rejected so CDOT will set barrier on the shoulders for now. Probably a couple years before Bridge Enterprise funding is available to replace the rail and decking.

Paul Jagim-under construction on pedestrian crosswalks on Horizon Drive. Completion expected in March.

Rob Beck-Mack to Fruita overlay this summer. We will be adding a lane to the 22 Road DDI.

Biz-route changes went into effect.

Sam Atkins-Maple Street sewer being replaced by the school.

Trent Prall-7th Street reconstruction from Orchard to Patterson this summer. Las Colonias going strong. Early stage planning activity for development of the Dos Rios/Jarvis property.
